- Complete application
- Salary or grant verification form – verified by employer or caseworker
- Marriage license or divorce decree
- Court documents verifying legal guardianship of other family members
- Social security cards for all household members
- CIB for all household members
- Birth Certificates for all household members
- Veteran status – copy of your DD-214 document
- Rental History – within the past 3 years
- Criminal/Drug History – for all household members over 18 years of age
- Authorization for the release of information/privacy act

The Navajo Housing Authority (NHA) Section 8 Program, also known as The Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) is designated to assist low income Navajo families rent apartment or homes in the private market for one year.

Once applicants are determined eligible, their applications are scored and placed on a wait list according to preference points they have received. Each month briefing sessions are conducted; families will be notified to attend these sessions.

When an applicant's preference has been verified and the family is next on the waiting list, the family shall be issued a voucher. NHA shall brief the applicant on the HCV program.

The briefing session will cover all rules and regulations pertaining to the family's and owner's responsibilities under the program.

Once a family has been approved through HCV, they will be responsible to submit a Request for Tenancy Approval which is signed by the applicant and Property Manager or Homeowner. A Housing Quality Inspection will be scheduled and once the unit has passed, a Housing Assistance Payment Contract will be executed.

The family has 60 days to lease an apartment or house; starting with the day they receive their voucher. The family will be given payment standards for the location in which they plan to reside.

### Housing Cont'd

Under the HCV Program, the tenant rent will vary based on the applicant's income, total contract rent and its relationship to the Payment Standards. The HCV Payment Contract is executed the day after the unit has passed the Housing Quality Standards Inspection. Applicants are required to pay 30% of adjusted income.

HCV Contracts are effective for ONE YEAR only. Tenants can stay in their rental units after their contract term but will be responsible for the entire rent thereafter.

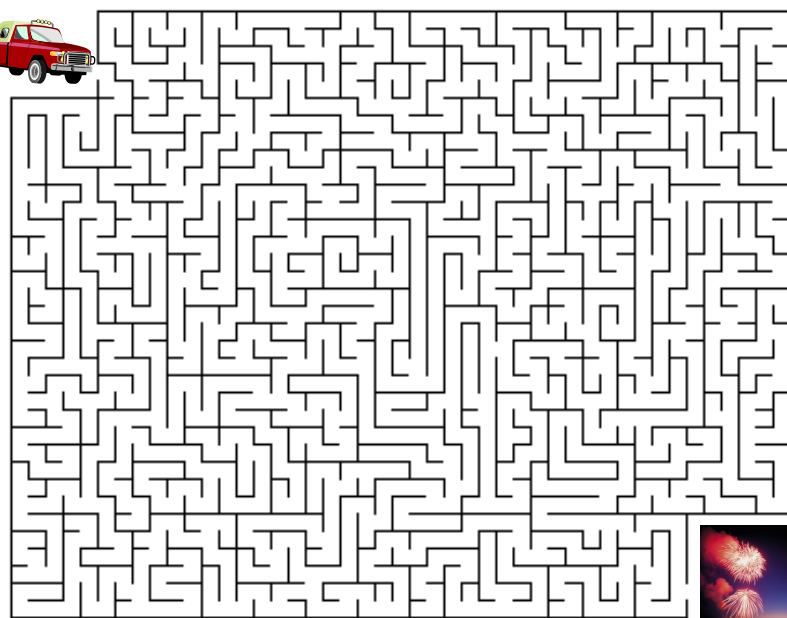
